



## COOKIES POLICY OF THE WEB

### In relation to cookies while browsing

The cookie (or computer cookie) is a small information sent by a website and stored in the user's browser, so that the website can consult the previous activity of the user.

Cookie Name	Type	Purpose	Duration
viewed_cookie_policy	Needed	The cookie is defined by the cookie consent connector of the GDPR and is used to show whether or not the user has consented to the use of cookies. It does not store any personal data.	11 months
cookieawinfo-checkbox-no-necessary	Needed	This cookie is defined by the GDPR cookie consent plugin. Cookies are used to give the user's consent to cookies in the "Not required" category.	1 year
